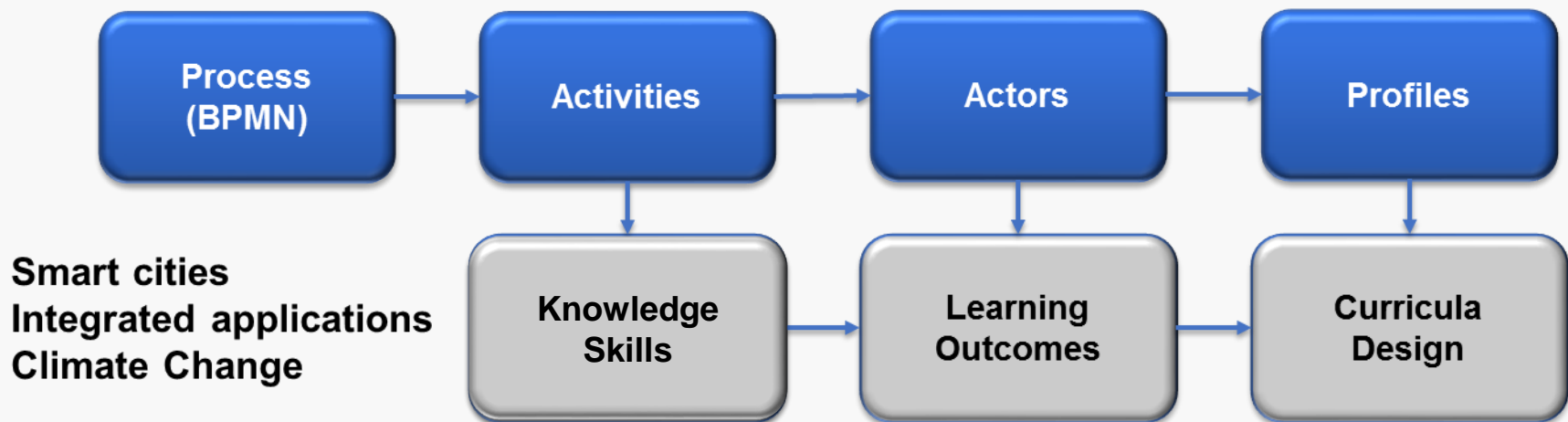

Curricula design in EO4GEO

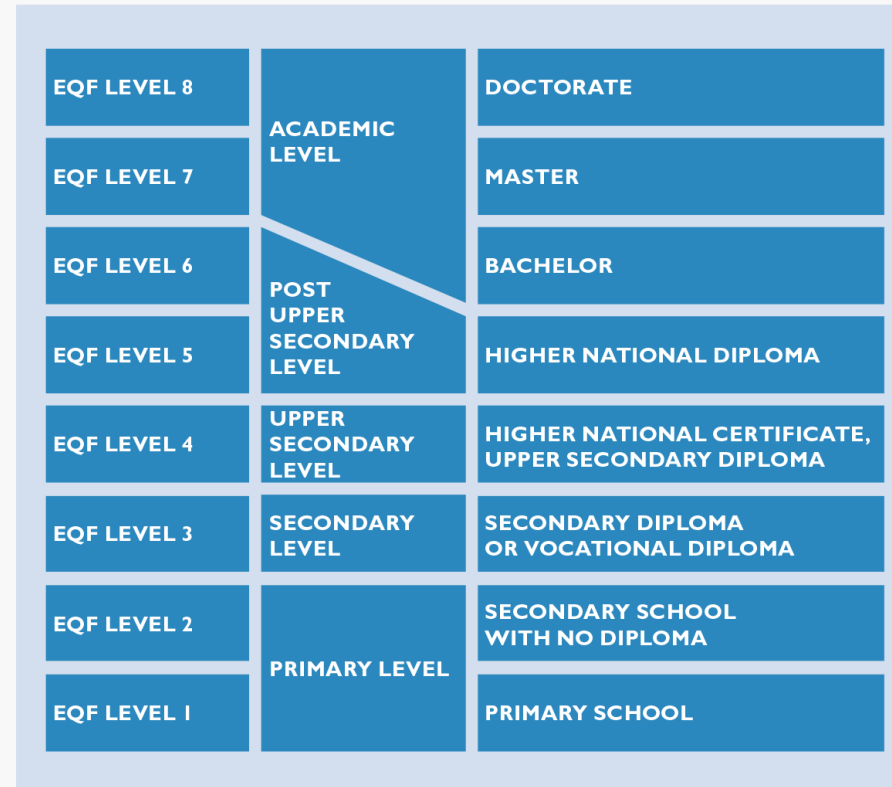
- Identifying and defining a set of work processes (32+) in the field of Climate Change, Smart Cities and Integrated Applications

 - By certain actors ... who can cover one or more profiles



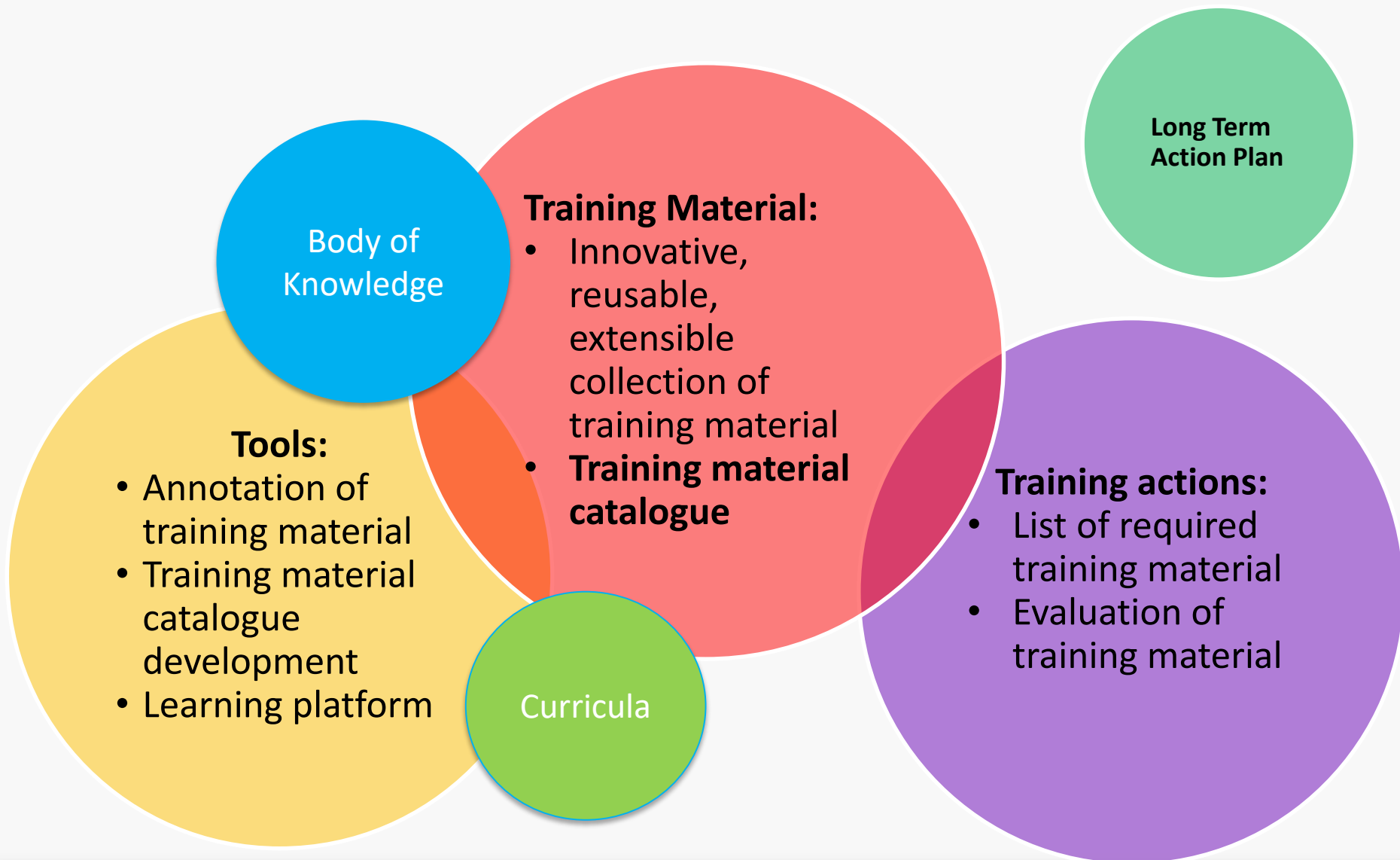
Definition: Curricula

- High school education

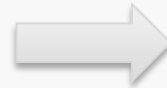

 - the European Green Deal
 - the European Digital Strategy
 - the new Industrial and Small and Medium Enterprise Strategy, along with the European Education Area



Blueprint for sectoral cooperation on skills

Roll-out at national and regional level

Building on the achievements of the sectoral skills alliances at EU level, the ‘blueprint’ for the sector will be rolled out at national and regional level.

This will be done **cooperation with national and regional authorities**, in and key stakeholders. There will also be synergies with other policy frameworks, such as regional smart specialisation strategies.

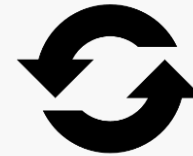

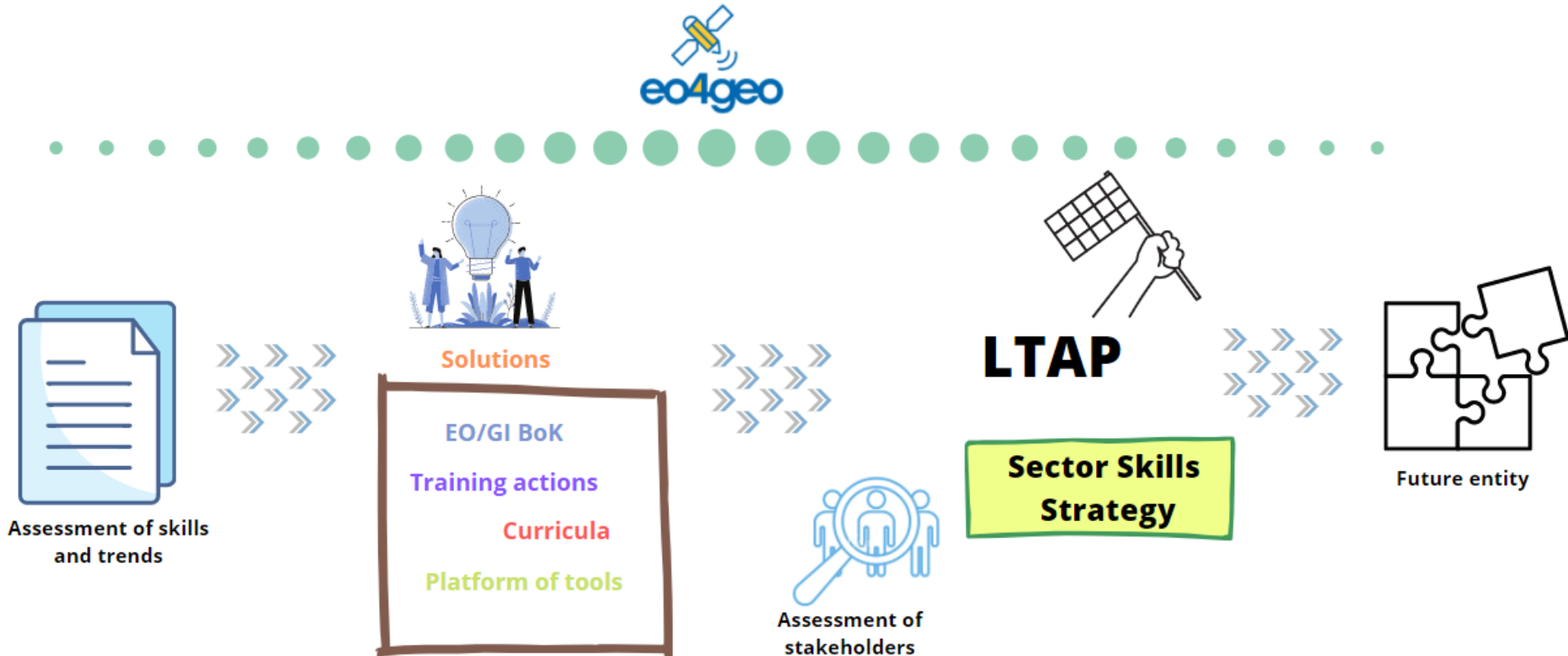
