Copernicus Accademy:

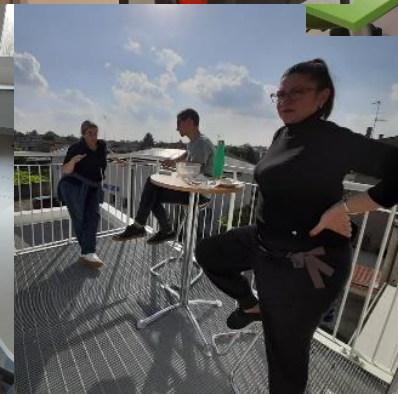
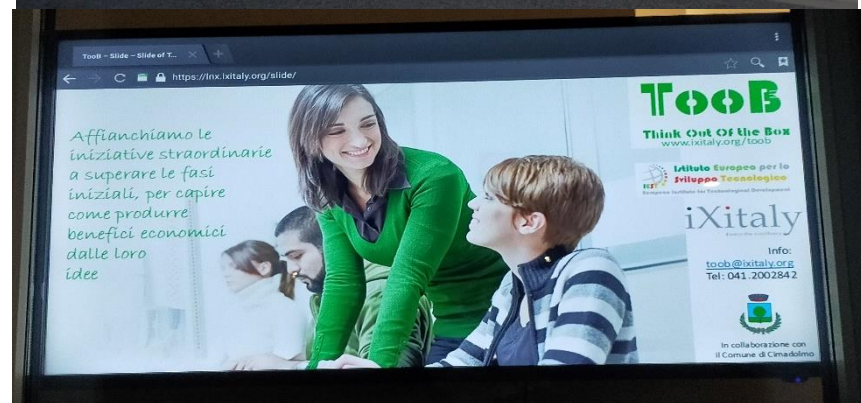

IEST presented the following proposal:

- Copernicus Stakeholder Identification and Engaging potential Copernicus stakeholders at local level
 - analyse, through direct interviews, the degree of knowledge in companies in the sector and high technology, the degree of knowledge of the Copernicus system
 - verify the level of use, real and potential, of this data
 - check the degree and limits of use based on different targets:
 - technology startups
 - companies in the sector
 - public bodies (no research)

The work was carried out in coordination with the CNR and the TERN

- Results are on Deliverabile D 2,1



IEST presented the following proposal:

- Local information events on Copernicus data and services
 1. involve local stakeholder holders
 2. meetings were held with representatives of the structures representing companies such as trade associations and chambers of commerce,
 3. meetings were held with startups and 2 groups were brought to Marseille and Helsinki respectively, on the acceleration paths for the development of business ideas.
 4. agreements have been made with the region, to use satellite data - even beyond Copernicus - made available by the regional body as a basis for local knowledge elements this work was used to start involving the territory and the stakeholders.

Unfortunately the covid- has stopped and slowed everything down and made it very difficult to continue.

The reorganization has led to the need to have virtual meetings instead of carrying out public meetings

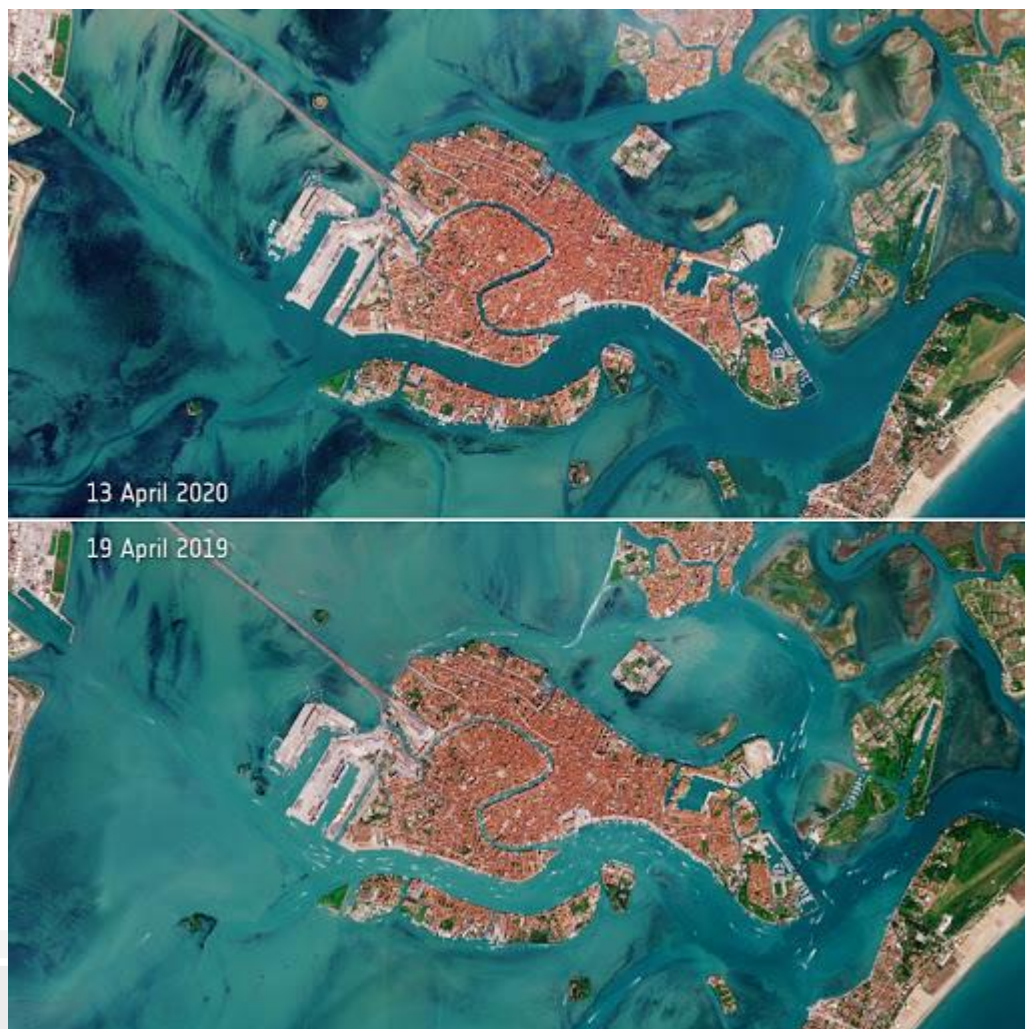
IEST works in the field of Earth observation, it is easier to see how blind we are, in front of our beautiful planet and the respect we owe to it.

Agenda 2030 with the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), expresses a clear judgment on the unsustainability of the current development model.

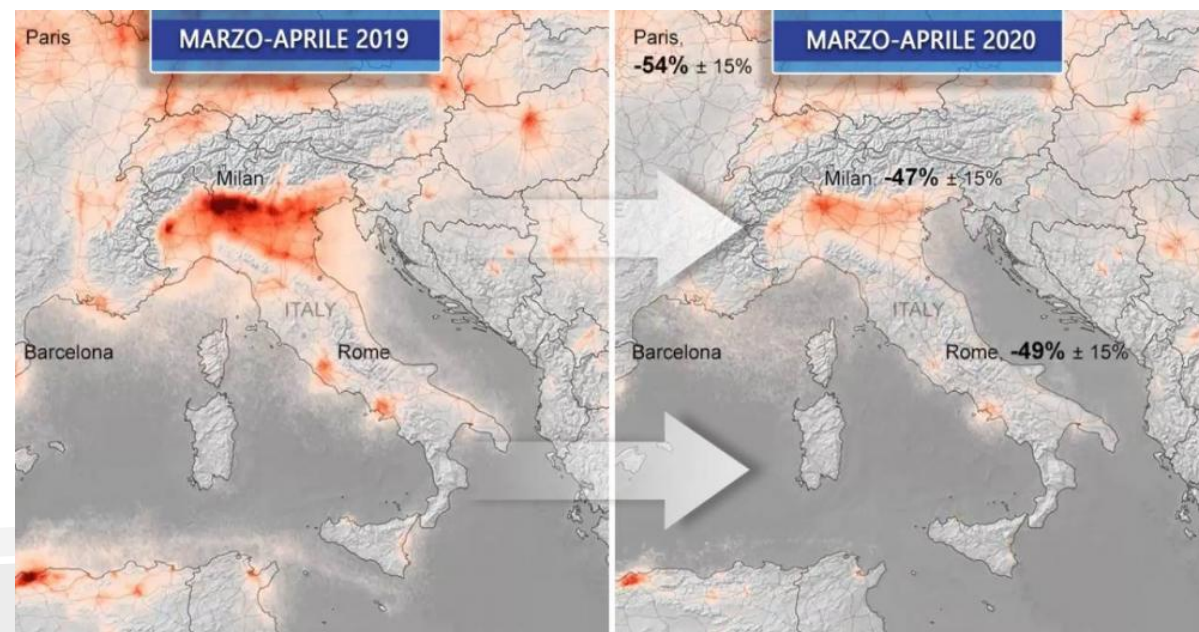
Main driver for the next
