# **UNIVERSEH STAKEHOLDERS**

UNIVERSEH positions itself in the context of a very dynamic space sector.

Government space programme budgets worldwide are growing, reaching close to EUR 70 bn in 2020 to cover exploration and scientific activities. Commercial space applications continue to develop and diversify into new areas. The market for satellite communications and connectivity is forecast to exceed EUR 15 bn, and the market for Earth observation services is expected to reach more than EUR 6 bn in 2029. Satellite constellations is forecast to lead to a five-fold increase in the average number of satellites launched per year by 2029<sup>1</sup>.
