The workshops have the overall objective to promote the EO4GEO sector skills alliance towards the relevant Polish business and academic community but also to get their views on the initiative. Thus, they will introduce the participants to the EO4GEO sector skills alliance, present and debate the Sector Skills Strategy with particular focus on local and regional authorities and end users. The objectives:

- Identify the right EO/GI occupational profile for the Polish business community;
- Current and future needs in EO/GI educational training for business activities/ administrations;
- Raise awareness on the EO4GEO initiative to relevant stakeholder communities;
- Promotion of the EO4GEO tools to the Polish audience;

Feed-back from the Polish community on the EO4GEO Sector Skills Strategy.

The initiative: The outreach-workshops are embedded in the ERASMUS+-funded initiative **EO4GEO**, a Sector skills Alliance project of 26 partners from 13 EU countries, most of which are part of the Copernicus Academy Network, and active in the **education and training fields of the space / geospatial sectors**.

Audience: Everyone interested in Education, Training, Skills Development and Capacity Building in the Geo-information sector/Copernicus: Representatives of regions, public authorities using space data and interested to develop necessary skills, education and training organisations, universities, businesses active in the geo-information and space sectors, and any other interested stakeholders are invited to join the workshop.
