How Copernicus helps Europe's regions to innovate public administrations and the delivery of public policies

Copernicus can greatly help public authorities to fulfil their undertakings, especially in areas such as environmental monitoring and adaptation to climate change. However, the adoption of new technologies by public administrations is rarely straightforward (see also **previous analyses**).
