







Outcomes following the implementation of the activity:

- Increased realisation/recognition of the need of Skills Development and Capacity Building, Traning/Education
- Interregional cooperations and partnerships of regions with similar interests and profiles is an important assett to mobilize public administrations
- More regions explore interregional cooperations e.g. INTERREG
- More regions look into defining exploitation strategies for space data
- More regions bring the dimension of space into their regional strategies, in particular into their Smart Specialisation Strategies (S3)

- More regions and responsible for territoral challenges discuss and explore how satellite data could help policy maker to take better decisions
