

Advice

- ✓ Check carefully admissibility and eligibility conditions
- ✓ Read carefully the topic description (scope, expected impact) does the proposal match the expectations
- ✓ Fill in the proposal templates- following the instructions
- √ Fill in the mandatory annexes
- ✓ Address thoroughly the selection and award criteria
- √ Respect page limits
- ✓ Clearly describe what you will achieve and how you will do it
- ✓ Choose your consortium based on your project needs /e.g. no duplications or partners
 without clear responsibilities
- ✓ Describe carefully the impact
- ✓ Submit well before the final deadline

13 Common mistakes

- Planning: #Mistake1 The project has not been planned out adequately
- Consortium quality: #Mistake2 Not choosing the right partners
- **Proposal author**: #Mistake3 The flow of the proposal is disjointed due to multi-actor approach
- Proposal content: #Mistake4 Proposal written as if it was a scientific paper #Mistake5 Not using enough images/diagrams/tables etc.
 #Mistake6 Construction of the proposal not well though out
- Abstract & Introduction: #Mistake7 The abstract or Introduction does not capture the evaluators attention
- The scientific story: #Mistake8 The scientific story is chaotic and is not coherent #Mistake9 Principles of scientific soundness have not been followed
- Impact section: #Mistake10 Not clearly stating the project impacts
- Appropriate methodologies: #Mistake11 Methodologies not appropriate for a diverse multi-research approach
- Implementation Quality/Efficiency:: #Mistake12 Quality of implementation does not support Excellence & Impact #Mistake13 The quality of the Consortium is not adequately highlighted
