PROGRAMME

The European Commission proposed on 25 June 2025, a Space package comprised of the European Space Act and the Vision of a European Space Economy. The legislative package and vision aim to create a strong EU Single Market that empowers European space players/companies to benefit from a stable and competitive business environment and protects space-based data and services. The space package addresses space safety and sustainability, market development, security and resilience, innovation and skills, and governance/procurement. The idea is to work against the fragmentation of the market (e.g. 13 different national space laws in Europe) and enhance stronger harmonisation across the Union.

Objectives:

This webinar aims to

- Introduce the EC proposal, bringing it into context while focusing on key objectives and impact. Understand the scope of the EU Space Act, why the EC proposed it now, and how it impacts different stakeholders along the value chain and public authorities. Present ideas of a secure, green, competitive European space economy.
- Provide an overview of benefits/added value, timelines, and challenges for enterprises (what is the added financial, legal, and human resource effort?), get a better understanding of the role of regional/local administrations to promote the law's impact and effectiveness.
- Stimulate interaction and exchange of European stakeholders from relevant domains, to exchange on their different viewpoints and perspectives.
