## DESCRIPTION, OBJECTIVES & TARGET AUDIENCE

Info session on the latest developments regarding the EU Space Package (EU Space Act and Vision for a European Space Economy) that is currently negotiated in the European Parliament and Council. Series of online events, Time duration: 90 minutes

### **Short description of the session:**

On 25 June 2025, the European Commission (EC) presented a Space Package composed of two elements: the proposed EU Space Act and the Vision for the European Space Economy. The legislative package aims to create a strong EU Single Market that empowers European space players/companies to benefit from a stable and competitive business environment and protects space-based data and services. The space package addresses space safety and sustainability, market development, security and resilience, innovation and skills, and governance/procurement. The idea is to work against the fragmentation of the market (e.g. 13 different national space laws in Europe) and enhance stronger harmonisation across the Union. The proposal is expected to lay down rules on the authorisation, registration and supervision of space activities and services carried out by space service providers; orbit traffic management; and the establishment of an EU space label.

Now the proposal is being negotiated by the co-legislators, the European Parliament (Committee on Industry, Research and Energy (ITRE), MEP Elena Donazzan (ECR, Italy) rapporteur) and the Council (space working group). On 9 December 2025, Ministers debated the proposal at the Competitiveness Council, expressing general support for its objectives while stressing the need for simplification.
